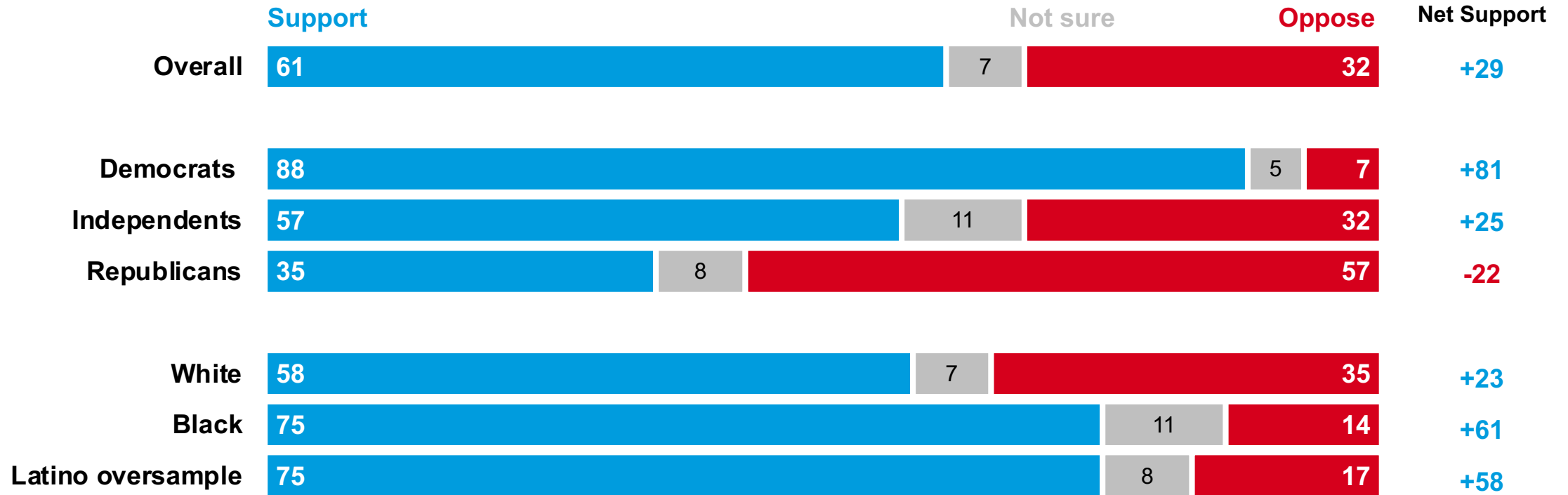


Three in five support Temporary Protected Status for undocumented immigrants, including a majority of independents

As you may know, there is a government program called the Temporary Protected Status (TPS) program that gives temporary status to immigrants who have gone through background checks, are already living in the United States, and have come from countries that have been severely affected by dangerous conditions, political turmoil, or natural disasters.

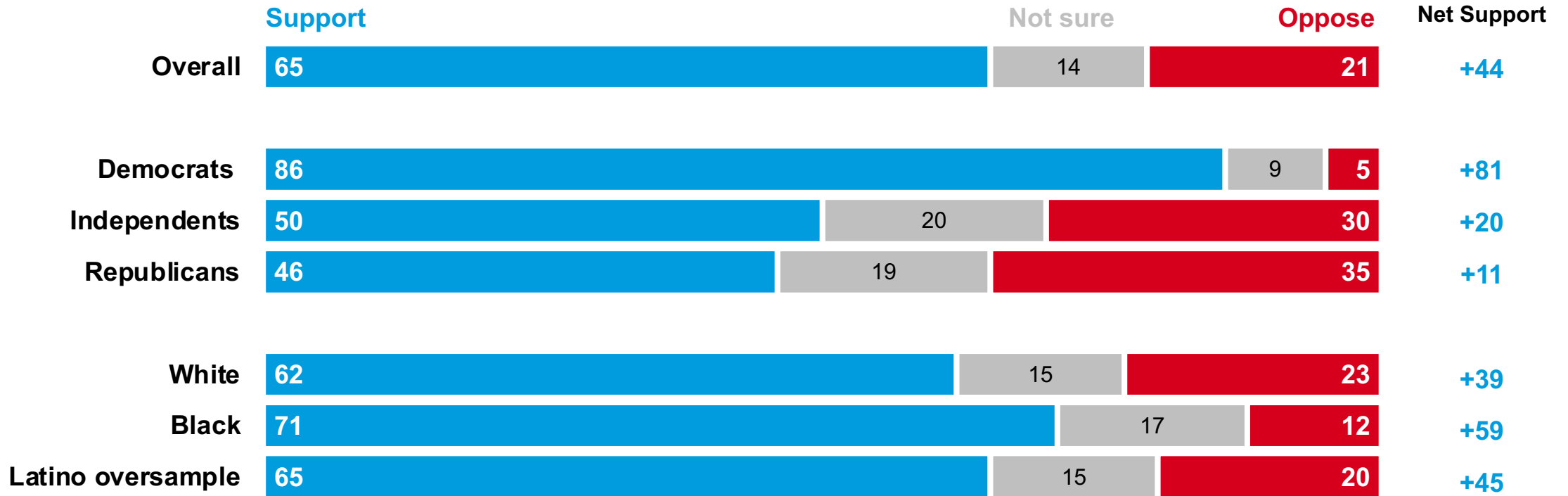
Do you support President Biden using this program to provide temporary protected status to undocumented immigrants who meet these requirements, allowing them to stay and work in the U.S.?
